- This office received two complaints from pumper to pumper. One anonymous and one in person. Found neither to be valid complaints and both to be in compliance.
- Free water test mailers have started hitting mailboxes out in our area from a private company. They come out to your home and test your water. Not sure what kind of testing the private company does for the purpose of selling a filtration system. Posted on social media that those groups are not affiliated with the county health departments.
- Contractor's workshop was on the February 25 and is held every 3 years. Had 30 attendees. Started out with a presentation from Rick Kerpatrick Infiltrator Water Technologies. Spent a lot of time talking about the technology and on proper installation. Talked about cesspools and the dangers of having them and sealing them up. Went over the new land application permit that was board approved.
- State committees holding hearings on possibly splitting KDHE into two separate entities. Initial plan was to have a separate Kansas Department of Environment and a Kansas Department of Health.

- The next board meeting is tentatively scheduled for Thursday, June 16, 2022 @ noon.

Meeting was adjourned at 4:22 PM.


